



## ROBERT M. WILLIAMS SCHOLARSHIPS

This Scholarship is in honor of Robert M. Williams for his contribution to the Loveland community. Mr. Williams served the community in many capacities, but his love of people and his involvement in athletics with his children, grandchildren and friends will live on with this scholarship.

Robert M. Williams always knew the score of life and was dedicated to the individuals within these sports and not just the scoreboard. The Robert M. Williams Scholarship is open to Senior Athletes and Senior Sport Managers. As a reflection of how Bob lived his life, the recipient should possess a strong moral character, that is reflected in their leadership, school spirit and positive attitude toward their teammates and coaches.

The scholarship should be used to help fund higher education at an accredited University, College or Technical school. Applicants must have maintained a minimum of a 2.5 GPA.

### ***To be eligible to apply for this scholarship, a student must:***

- Have completed any inter-scholastic athletic program of Loveland High School for a minimum of 2 years
- Have parents/guardians that are current, active members of LAB and have completed the necessary volunteer hours

***The response to the following question will be considered in choosing the recipients. Please prepare a 2-3 paragraph response. Please be sure your name is on top your essay.***

What or who inspired you during your senior year as a player/team manager.

***You will also need to submit a letter written by a recent coach that explains to the LAB Scholarship Committee your character and unselfish attitude.***

- Be sure to have the coach write your name on the top of the letter
- Be sure to reach out to coaches early to provide them plenty of time
- You are responsible for getting the letter and submitting it with your application/essay

The Robert M. Williams Scholarship is a non-renewable \$1,000 scholarship (given to two winners). The Scholarship committee of the Loveland Athletic Boosters will select the recipients.

Scholarships will be directly paid to the parents or guardians of the recipient.

A grade transcript must be uploaded along with your essay and letter from coach.

All applications are **due MARCH 1<sup>st</sup>** and **MUST** be submitted online.
